WHAT WE OFFER

Weekly Family Education Workshops

- 12-week rotating curriculum (join anytime).
- Topics like Boundaries, Healthy Attachment, Family Roles, Self-Care, and more.
- Facilitated by trained staff with lived experience and clinical background.

Family Support Groups

- Monthly community events featuring family recovery stories.
- Resource sharing, Q&A, and Narcan distribution.

Support Calls for Families

- Families can speak with a peer about options and get connected to help.
- Support for loved ones currently using, in treatment, or in recovery.

Family Therapy Sessions

- Individualized family sessions with licensed clinicians.
- Focus on healing relationships, structure, and communication.

WHY REFER TO US?

- Evidence-based model designed by DMH & Recovery Lighthouse.
- Open to ALL families, even if their loved one is not in treatment.
- Helps support recovery, reduce stigma, and strengthen families.

WHO THIS PROGRAM HELPS

- Families of individuals struggling with opioid or other substance use.
- Parents, siblings, partners, adult children, and other concerned loved ones.
- Families who feel stuck, exhausted, confused, or hopeless.
- Families who want to help a loved one enter treatment or maintain recovery.
- Anyone impacted by substance use in the family – even if their loved one isn't ready for help.

- Services available now— no waitlist.
- Walk-In support and immediate access to resources.
- You do not need to have a loved one in treatment to participate—this program is for you.
- Monday-Friday availability.
